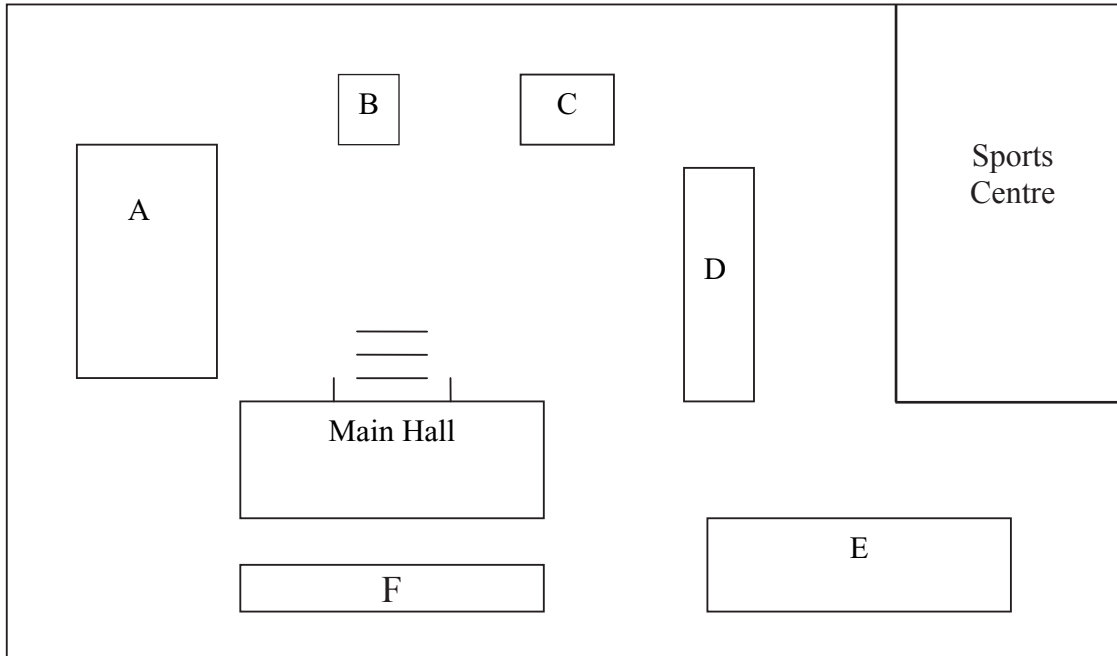

WATER – A VALUABLE RESOURCE

LOCATION OF WATER

- 97% of the earth’s water is salt water – found in oceans
- 3% of the earth’s water is fresh water – mostly stored in:
 - ~ glaciers
 - ~ icecaps
 - ~ [21]
- Only 1% of fresh water available for immediate use – found underground and on surface in:
 - ~ lakes
 - ~ rivers
 - ~ [22]

IRRIGATION

- First developed 7000 years ago
- Still used today
- Inefficient because [26] of the water evaporates
