

Take a screenshot showing cells A1 to G5 of the spreadsheet, including row and column headings. Place this in your Evidence Document.

• In cell E5 enter a formula to calculate the price per square metre which is the price divided by the area. Use a function to round this value to 0 decimal places. [3]

- In cell G5 enter a formula to calculate the travel cost to this property. This is 10 rupees plus:
 - 7.5 if the distance is less than 6
 - The distance multiplied by 1.5 if the distance is not less than 6
 - Round the travel cost up to the next whole rupee.
