

## Manatees Adventures

Manatees Adventures provide boat trips to view the endangered manatee on St Johns River. The boat, the Osprey, can take up to 60 passengers at a time. The captain of the Osprey is a local and acts as a tour guide giving a full description of the area during the trip. The best time to visit is in the winter when the weather is cold, and the water is clear.

As well as manatees you can see alligators, bald eagles, osprey, ibis and more. On the two and a half hour trip you may not see any wildlife, however, the captain will offer lots of history and information about the area.

Onboard the Osprey there are toilets, a shop selling souvenirs, drinks and snacks.
